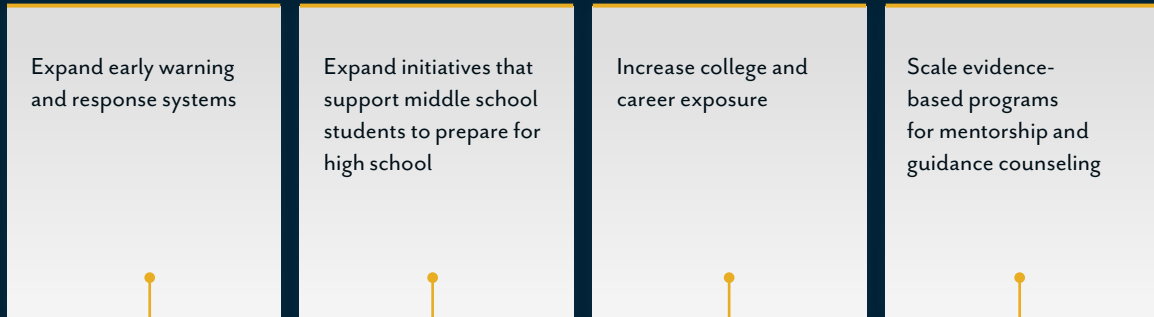


HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION: OUR THEORY OF CHANGE

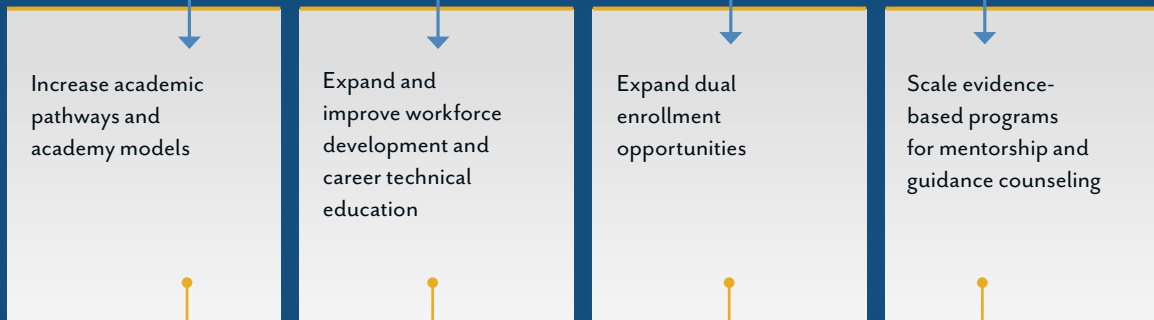
MIDDLE SCHOOL OUTCOME

- On-time promotion to high school

- Career preparedness
- College readiness
- High school completion

How We Measure

- Attendance rates (students attending at least 95% of days)
- AP, IB, dual-enrollment or CTE course enrollment
- Keystone (Algebra and Literature)
- Four-year and six-year graduation rates
- College matriculation and completion rates
